State of Wisconsin ex rel. Timothy Zignego v. Wisconsin Elections
Commission (L.C. # 2019CV449)

The Wisconsin Elections Commission and individual Commissioners (collectively, “the Commission”) have moved for relief pending appeal in the form of a stay of the circuit court’s contempt order entered on January 13, 2020. This appeal concerns that contempt order only.

¹ This appeal is a one-judge appeal pursuant to WIS. STAT. § 752.31(2)(h) (2017-18).

The Commission requests that its motion be considered “ex parte,” in this context meaning without a response from the respondents. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.12 (“A judge of the court may issue an ex parte order granting temporary relief pending a ruling by the court on a motion filed pursuant to this rule.”).

By separate order today, a three-judge panel of this court has stayed the circuit court’s order for a writ of mandamus that underlies the contempt order. In light of that order, I now grant a temporary stay of the contempt order.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the circuit court’s contempt order is temporarily stayed pending further order of this court.
