The Wisconsin Elections Commission and individual Commissioners (collectively, "the Commission") have moved for relief pending appeal in the form of a stay of the circuit court's contempt order entered on January 13, 2020. This appeal concerns that contempt order only.

The Commission requests that its motion be considered "ex parte," in this context meaning

without a response from the respondents. See WIS. STAT. RULE 809.12 ("A judge of the court

may issue an ex parte order granting temporary relief pending a ruling by the court on a motion

filed pursuant to this rule.").

By separate order today, a three-judge panel of this court has stayed the circuit court's

order for a writ of mandamus that underlies the contempt order. In light of that order, I now

grant a temporary stay of the contempt order.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the circuit court's contempt order is temporarily stayed pending

further order of this court.
