No. 2020AP1749-OA Lindoo v. Evers (Polk Cty. Circuit Court #2020CV219)

A "Conditional Petition to the Supreme Court of Wisconsin for Removal of a Case from the Polk County Circuit Court as an Original Action, or, in the alternative, to Exercise its Superintending Authority and Assume Jurisdiction of that Case" having been filed on behalf of petitioners, Derek Lindoo, Brandon Widiker, and John Kraft, and a response in opposition to the conditional petition having been filed on behalf of respondent, Tony Evers, in his official capacity as Governor of the State of Wisconsin; and the court noting that an action with the same parties raising similar issues is currently pending in the Polk County Circuit Court as Case No. 20CV219; and the court further noting that on October 28, 2020, it granted a petition for leave to commence an original action in <u>Fabick v. Evers</u>, No. 2020AP1718-OA;

IT IS ORDERED that the "Conditional Petition to the Supreme Court of Wisconsin for Removal of a Case from the Polk County Circuit Court as an Original Action, or, in the alternative, to Exercise its Superintending Authority and Assume Jurisdiction of that Case" is denied; and IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioners in this matter may file a non-party brief amicus curiae in <u>Fabick v. Evers</u> no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 4, 2020. The non-party brief shall not exceed 20 pages if a monospaced font is used or 4,400 words if a proportional serif font is used. The brief shall be filed as an attachment in pdf format to an email addressed to clerk@wicourts.gov. The petitioners shall also ensure a paper original and 10 copies of the brief are received by the clerk within 24 hours of the electronic filing with the following notation on the top of the first page: "This document was previously filed via email;" and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all proceedings in <u>Lindoo v. Evers</u>, Polk County Case No. 20CV219, are hereby stayed pending this court's decision in <u>Fabick v. Evers</u> and until further order of this court.
